Dear AFDA Members,

After much thought, discussion and seeking viable alternatives in which the association could safely hold the annual fire districts training conference, the AFDA Board of Directors determined it was in the best interest of the association and its' members to cancel the January 2021 AFDA Training Conference. AFDA is planning to implement a number of one-day training sessions in its' place to ensure newly elected and reelected fire board members can obtain their required statutory training (approximately 325 newly elected or reelected fire officials will take office this general election cycle).

The AFDA will provide an expanded slate of one-day statutory training opportunities for all newly elected or re-elected fire board members. The one-day statutory training classes will be held throughout Arizona starting in December 2020. Details for the one-day statutory training sessions will be finalized in the coming weeks. Class sizes will be limited, and all local and state COVID-19 pandemic safety protocols will be followed. In addition, AFDA will be professionally filming the statutory classes for use by AFDA members wishing to complete the six-hours of mandated training independent of the group training sessions.

AFDA has preliminarily scheduled five stand-alone one-day statutory training sessions. Additional training sessions will be scheduled dependent upon need.
