Completed application packets must be received no later than 16:00 hours on **November 19, 2020**. Following the closing date, all application packets will be reviewed based upon the qualifications and criteria outlined in this information packet. Those candidates that the department determines to be the best qualified will be invited to participate in a one-day assessment center to be held on December 8, 2020. Participation in the assessment center will be at the candidates' expense.

The successful candidate shall be subject to a complete background investigation, along with pre-employment physical examination, drug screening, fingerprinting, and criminal and motor vehicle background check.
