Verde Valley Fire District Job Announcement

Verde Valley Fire District is currently accepting applications for the position of full-time Fire Inspector.

Verde Valley Fire District is a combination fire/EMS agency that provides fire suppression, EMS, technical rescue, wildland, fire prevention and many other services to the residents of the unincorporated areas around the City of Cottonwood as well as the communities of Cornville and Page Springs and the Town of Clarkdale. The District covers approximately 104 square miles, serves approximately 21,300 residents, and responds to approximately 3,400 calls per year.

Minimum Qualifications

To perform the job successfully, an individual must be able to satisfactorily perform each essential duty as listed in the job description. The applicant must also meet the following minimum qualifications:

- ◆ Minimum of 18 years old.
- ◆ High school diploma or equivalent.
- ◆ Completion of Fire Investigation course equivalent to the IAAI or NFA that meets the requirements of the NFPA 1033 (or obtain within 2 years of hire date).
- ◆ Certification for Fire Inspector, or equivalent, that meets requirements of NFPA 1031 (or obtain within 1 year of hire date).
- ◆ Certification in a nationally recognized Fire Code (or obtain within 6 months of hire date).
- ◆ Fire Prevention Basic Certificate or completed studies in Fire Sciences.
- ◆ Completion of NIMS 100, 200, 300, 700 and 800 (or obtain within 6 months of hire date).
- ◆ 40 Hour Hazardous Materials Course.
- ◆ Certified Car Seat Technician (or obtain within 6 months of hire date).
- ◆ Valid Arizona State unrestricted Driver's License.
- ◆ Must be able to read, write and speak the English language.
- ◆ Must be able to successfully complete an annual job-related physical and medical evaluation, including drug screen.
- ◆ Must successfully pass a complete background check.
- ◆ Must meet the insurability requirements of the District's insurance carrier.

Compensation and Benefits

Wage Range: \$22.39 - \$35.79; approx \$46,571 - \$74,443 annually.

Verde Valley Fire District offers a premium benefits package that includes:

Application Process
