Ehrenberg Fire district covers approximately 48 square miles and provides 24 hour fire suppression and emergency medical service to residents and visitors to Ehrenberg, AZ.

We operate out of one centrally located station and respond to approximately 400 calls annually, as well as participating in fire prevention and other community activities and events.

Minimum Qualifications:

- High School Diploma, GED or equivalent
- Driver license
- Must be able to pass a background check and drug screening

Preferred Qualifications:

- Current Firefighter level I-II certification AZ State, IFSAC, or DOD
- Hazardous Material First Responder Operations AZ State, IFSAC or DOD
- Current NWCG S-130/S-190, L190 Wildland Firefighter II

Disqualifiers:

- Applicants must not have any felony convictions on record for 10 years
- Applicants must have no misdemeanor convictions on record for 5 years
- Inability to meet required shift attendance 48 hours per month (2 shifts)
- Inability to meet required weekly trainings

Schedule and Benefits:

- 24 hour shifts with sleeping quarters and kitchen at the station
- Use of station gym on or off duty
- Shift stipend rate currently at \$200.00 per 24 hour shift
- Ongoing training with AZ certified Fire Instructors, as well as attending outside training including Arizona State Fire School
