Job Title: Full Time Firefighter EMT

The following statements are intended to describe the general nature and level of work being performed and are not intended to be an exhaustive list of duties, skills and responsibilities.

General Job Description:

Firefighters perform public safety work involving the protection of life and property by fighting fires, mitigating emergency incidents, treating, and transporting patients, and engaging in technical rescue and hazardous materials response. Firefighters also are responsible for related training, public education and outreach, and station and equipment maintenance activities.

Firefighters are responsible for performing related duties as required.

The firefighter EMT is responsible to maintain continuous certification and renewal of credentials as an Arizona EMT and performance acceptable to the Fire District's base hospital and medical director. The firefighter EMT also is responsible for special and advanced training skills as assigned.

Successful applicants must achieve an arduous rating on the NWCG work capacity test and must renew the arduous rating annually.

Applicant must pass full background check, drug/alcohol screening, and physical ability test. Selected applicant will be hired on a probationary status for not less than one year.
