CRITERIA TO BE USED IN ESTABLISHING THE ELIGIBILITY LIST:

- Review of application and supporting documents
- Written exam
- Practical exam

NOTE: Preference points will be awarded for military service if a valid DD form 214 is submitted with the candidate's application.

The firefighter works under the supervision of a fire captain or his/her assigned representative. The firefighter responds to alarms and protects life and property by performing firefighting, emergency medicine, hazard control and other duties as assigned. The firefighter also maintains fire and emergency medical equipment, apparatus, and facilities. (SEE POSTED JOB DESCRIPTIONS)
