- Written exam- Basic Firefighter, EMT/CEP, and pump theory/hydraulics
- Physical Agility- Pass/Fail or provide a current CPAT.
- Oral Board.
- Practical exam- Hydraulic calculation and Pumping.
- Chief's Interview with top 5 candidates.

* Preference will be given to those candidates that provide or display proficiency in engineering/hydraulics, pump theory. Have an Engine Boss qualification or a background/knowledge in Wildland Urban Interface.
