1 A.R.S. 48-807 was amended by laws 2022, chapter 171 (SB 1093) The maximum allowable tax rate increases from \$3.2500 to \$3.3750 for tax year 2022, \$3.5000 for tax year 2023 and \$3.37500 for tax year 2024 and each tax year thereafter.

2 A.R.S. 48-807 was amended by laws 2016, Chapter 183. This allows for any two or more fire districts that merge or consolidate to form a consolidated district on or after July 1, 2014 to receive monies in an amount not to exceed the sum of the average of the amount of FDAT monies received by each of the consolidating or merging districts in the five fiscal years immediately preceding the merger or consolidation. The change became effective with the fiscal year starting July 1, 2016.

3 A.R.S. 48-806 was amended by laws 2022, Chapter 84 (HB 2699). If a district with outstanding bond indebtedness is merged or consolidated, the indebtedness shall not be assumed by all of the resulting district. Property tax levies to repay the indebtedness shall only be imposed in the portion of the resulting district that originally approved the bonds.
